

RC 3319.31 (C) Offenses

Automatic Revocation/Bars to Licensure

Pursuant to RC 3319.31(C), the State Board of Education must automatically revoke or deny issuance or renewal of the license, certificate or permit of any individual who is convicted, pleads guilty to, or is found guilty by a jury or a court of any of the following offenses.

Suspension of Licensed Employees

The district must suspend a licensed employee from all duties that require the care, custody, or control of a child during the pendency of the criminal action when a person is arrested, summoned or indicted for any of these offenses (RC 3319.40).

Disqualifying offenses—bus drivers

Bus drivers who have been convicted or pleaded guilty to any of the offenses listed below may not be employed and must be released from employment (RC 3327.10 (K)).

Disqualifying offenses—teachers

RC 3319.39(B)(3) prohibits a district from employing a “teacher” who has plead guilty to or been convicted of an offense listed in RC 3319.31, which includes the offenses listed below and the RC 3319.31(B)(2) offenses.

Reporting Offenses

Superintendents and board presidents must report these offenses, as required by RC 3319.313, beginning September 12, 2008.
