

VVHO VVE ARE

Tri Star Career Compact began providing career technical/locational training in 1983 to comply with mandate from the Ohio Department of Education stating that "all schools of Ohlo are mandated to meet vocational education standards". To answer that call for vocational education in our area, an Augilaize-Mercer County Joint Vocational School was proposed, but failed to come to fruition after a vocational school levy was voted down six times by the voters. As a result, a career compact agreement was made among St. Marys, Coldwater and Cellina adhool districts that now serves those districts as well as Fort Recovery, Marion Local, Minster, New Bremen, New Knowlile, and St. Henry school districts. Students attending Tri Star from these districts are offered half-day programs allowing the students to attend their home district for the other half of the day and still participate in activities at their district. The benefit to the local tax payers is that there is no mileage with funding coming from local districts, the state and through federal funds. For every \$100.00 spent by Joint Vocational Schools, Tri Star Career Compact spends approximately 514 00







