Technology Requirements

General Requirements for Tablets

Schools will need to meet <u>all</u> specifications as detailed in the *Full Technology Specifications for PARCC Spring* 2014 Field Test (www.parcconline.org/field-test-technology)

Tablet screen size must be 9.5 inches (10 inch class) or larger. In addition, external keyboards (wired or Bluetooth) are required for tablets.
