

- Sets a foundation for good board selfevaluation




A poor governance team is hard on the community!

The community will believe what it sees!






Let me get this straight...You're on the police department, but you spend most of your time putting out fires? How facinating!

According to Brochu

- It is best to have a single author (think Thomas Jefferson and the Declaration of Independence)
- Involve all the board members in the book's creation
- A well written handbook reinforces good board culture



According to Brochu

- The book allows an orientation for new members
 - Don't wait until they are elected
- It provides "cover and support"
- It provides the board's agreed upon rules versus a single member




The Berlin Handbook design

- 1. Preamble
 - 2. Mission, Goals, and Core Values
 - Deliberate in many voices but govern as one
 - 3. Description of Board Committees
 - 4. Board protocols, roles, and responsibilities
 - 5. Board meetings
 - 6. Glossary of organizations, terms and acronyms

So What's a Handbook?

- According to Webster:
 - 1: a book capable of being conveniently carried as a ready reference: manual

2 : a concise reference book covering a particular subject



- Some quick facts and figures every Board Member should know:
 - We have how many schools?
 - We have that many teachers?
 - Our budget is what?
 - We have how many mills?



- A Few History Lessons:
 - Public education a great story to tell
 - District's first school building
 - District firsts and notable alumni
 - Enrollment over the years



- Rules of engagement:
 - Board Member term of office
 - Oath of office
 - Compensation and expenses
 - Filling vacancies
 - Board officers
 - Committees



- Rules of the (sometimes rocky) road:
 - Public meetings
 - Rules of procedure (and who put Mr.
 Robert in charge anyway?)
 - Public records
 - Privacy of student records



- Levies and campaigns:
 - Rare it is for a Board Member not to go through a levy campaign
 - Know the rules
 - Avoid dumb mistakes that result in bad press for the district
