Triad's mission is to provide the highest quality education possible to <u>all</u> of its students. Currently, K-12 students number 937. As a district, Triad has great community and parent support. PTA and booster groups are active within the district.

The district is comprised of Triad High School 9-12, Triad Middle School 5-8, and Triad Elementary K-4. The district employs 73 certified employees and 43 classified as well as 10 administrative professionals.

Triad Local School District serves students from Champaign, Logan and Union Counties. It is one of the public school districts served by the Madison-Champaign County ESC, which provides a variety of services to its member districts. Students who wish to include technical or vocational subjects in their high school curriculum may attend classes at Ohio Hi-Point Career Center.

The district offers a wide range of academic, co-curricular, and extra-curricular programs, including an outstanding music program and a very active vocational agricultural program.

Background Information

The eighty-three square mile rural setting includes the villages of Cable, Mingo, North Lewisburg, and Woodstock. In 1957 three districts consolidated and a new school was built in a rural location equal distance from each town and renamed Triad. An OSFC project completed in 2002 resulted in a renovated elementary and middle school, along with the construction of a new 9-12 high school.

North Lewisburg is located on State Route 245 between West Liberty and Marysville. Urbana is approximately 15 miles away.
