Northwest Region Humanitarian Award

recognizes individuals and groups who actively engage in exceptional efforts to improve the welfare of others through their altruistic activities. The NW Region Humanitarian Award honors altruistic efforts both in the schools and community. The purpose is to recognize those demonstrating the ethics of kindness, benevolence, and sympathy in their schools and communities. These individuals have a sincere concern for those around them and go above and beyond the call of duty. This award is peer nominated and is awarded twice per year at the Northwest Region's Spring and Fall Conferences.
