Buckeye Valley Local School District 2020-2021 Learning Options

The Buckeye Valley Local School District will be offering **two** learning options for students and families for the 2020-2021 academic year.

Option #1: Barons Are Back

Student learning takes place in school with increased safety precautions, however Hybrid or Remote Learning may take place based on Ohio COVID-19 Risk Level Guidelines.

Over 60% of Ohioans are considered high-risk based on CDC guidance. High-risk individuals* are at an increased risk of severe illness and should take every precaution to guard against contracting COVID-19, including following higher risk level guidance outlined below. Option #2: Dedicated Online Option

All student learning takes place solely online via virtual curriculum provider. Enrollment will determine delivery model.

All student learning takes place in person, five days per week and is dependent upon Ohio COVID-19 Risk Level Guidelines

Safety Guidelines for Barons Are Back Operating Model

- Parents assess student health before school
- Masks/Face coverings required per district expectations (see following slide)
- Additional cleaning of surfaces
- Hand sanitizing
- Two students per seat on buses
- Lunchroom space expands to other areas
- > No visitors or volunteers
- No shared student supplies

- > No lockers (textbooks online)
- > One-way hallways when possible
- > Designated traffic patterns
- ➢ Breakfast & lunch grab and go
- Student clubs meet virtually
- > No field trips
- > No large group student events
- Y-Club operational

Masks/Face Covering Guidelines for Barons Are Back Operating Model



- > Teachers and Staff: Masks are required
- ➤ Grades PreK-2 Students: Masks are required on buses and in hallways but are not required in classrooms.
- ➤ Grades 3-5 Students: Masks are required on buses, in hallways and in classrooms. Mask Breaks will be scheduled.
- ➤ Grades 6-12 Students: Masks are required on buses and while inside all buildings.
- ➤ Health appeals for masks/face covering may be approved by the district and must be submitted to the district through the formal appeal process.
- ➤ The appeal process and forms will be available on the district website by August 7.
- ➤ Face shields and other measures may be approved through the appeals process.
- ➤ The district will work with Delaware General Health District to ensure that appeals are appropriately considered.

The BVLSD will follow County COVID-19 Risk Level to determine status of Barons Are Back Operating Model

Risk Level 1 Barons Are Back Students report 5 days a week following guidelines Risk Level 2 Barons Are Back Students report 5 days a week following additional safety guidelines

Risk Level 3 Hybrid 50% of students are assigned to attend school in alternating cohorts

Risk Level 4 Remote Learning 3.0 Students learn at home 5 days a week

Additional Information Regarding the Barons Are Back Operating Model

- The district or an individual building <u>may</u> be directed to closed by the Delaware County General Health District.
- If the Ohio Department of Health announcement regarding the County COVID risk level changes, the district response will be implemented at the start of the following week for parental planning purposes.
- If teacher and/or staff COVID-19 absenteeism outpaces available substitutes, the school <u>may</u> shift to a Hybrid Operating Model.

Barons Are Back Hybrid Operating Model due to Risk Level 3 COVID-19 Status

Hybrid

50% of students are assigned to attend school in alternating cohorts.

- In-Person and Online Instruction
- Increased Safety Protocols
- > 50% of students in school on a staggered schedule
- This plan allows for a reduced number of students in the buildings while providing a combination of inperson and online learning. All students attend inperson 2 days a week.
- Students will be placed into A and B groups based on geographic location attempting to keep families on the same schedule. During at home days, students will focus on online assignments or tasks assigned during the in-person days.

Remote Learning 3.0

All student learning takes place online following BV Curriculum with Buckeye Valley teachers

Option #2: Dedicated Online Option

All student learning takes place online five days per week and is not dependent upon the COVID-19 Risk Level.

- Curriculum is different than in-person Barons Are Back curriculum but meets Ohio Department of Education and State of Ohio Graduation Requirements.
- Requires a K-12 semester-long commitment.
- ➤ Fully online curriculum.
- Flexible daily schedule determined by family.
- Elementary students will need a parent or other responsible adult for daily support.
- Not all district courses will be available.
- ➤ District provided device.
- ➤ Weekly pick up of lunch/breakfast for those who qualify.
- Extracurricular activities are still available.
- High School online courses offer students flexibility and choices surrounding how & when they learn.
- Special Education services may be adjusted (pending IEP team review).
