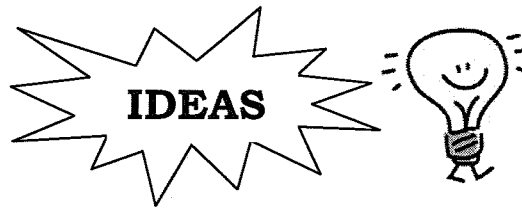

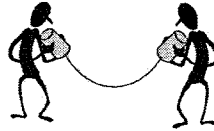

- Community and board support

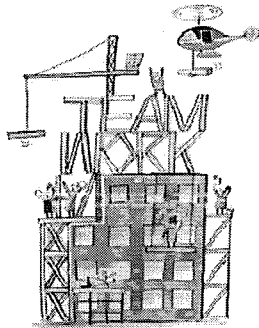

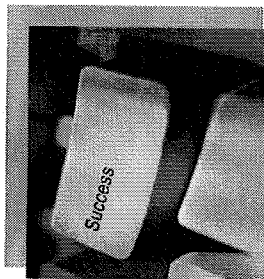
MISSION STATEMENT

PROGRAM GOALS

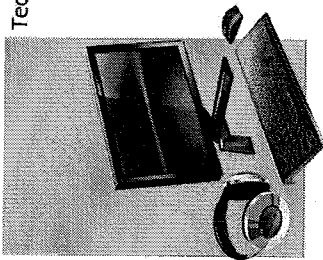
The Summit ATM Campus strives to:
