The Superintendent's responsibilities also include advising Board members on administrative matters, executing policies and decisions made by the Board and operating the District efficiently and effectively.

The new Superintendent will be an enthusiastic, instructional innovator whose consistent direction will lead the District in creating and sustaining an environment where every child will have the opportunity to academically flourish.

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate:

- Passionate ideals and beliefs about teaching and learning.
- The willingness and capability to provide instructional leadership to implement a personalized learning pathway system for all students with a focus on innovation, life skills, and career and college preparation.
- Provide a systematic structure to focus on a safe and secure environment for both students and staff, as well as provide the appropriate social and emotional supports needed to develop the whole child.
- Ability to engage and empower students, staff, parents and community. Listening and communication skills that develop positive relationships with the Board of Education and stakeholders listed above.
- Recognition of the value of visibility in the community and stakeholder input.
- The ability to develop, articulate and implement a vision for ongoing improvement of the District, including both short and longterm goals and plans.
- Exceptional educational team leadership skills which will result in the development and support of teaching and administrative talent, inspiration of high performance standards and the creation of organizational and individual accountability.
