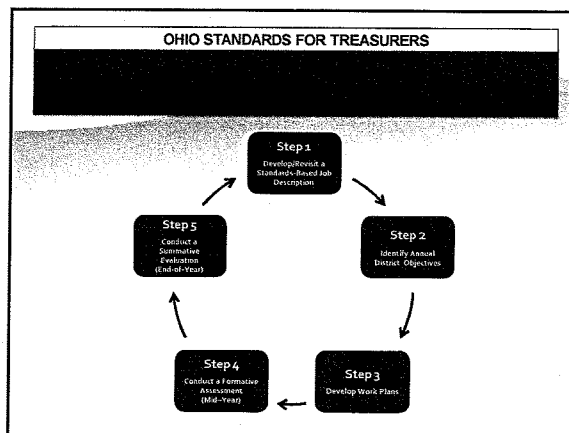

- Evaluation System based on Professional Standards
 - Committee Began work in June, 2011
 - Developed job descriptions
 - Developed an evaluation system
 - Standards Based
 - Annual Goal Setting
 - Formative and Summative Evaluations
- OASBO Board of Directors reviewed November 4, 2011
- To be completed by OASBO Annual Workshop, April 17-20, 2012



OASBO Update- Evaluation Project (cont'd)



- ♦ Evaluation System based on Professional Standards (continued)
 - Issues to be resolved
 - Definition of terms
 - District defined vs. system defined
 - Pilot Projects
 - Funding is an issue
 - Number of districts to be used
 - Identification and training of facilitators
 - Selection Process
- Promotion to school boards and superintendents

- ♦ Created a sub-committee of our Education Finance/ODE Advisory Committee
 - Invited other associations to participate

- ♦ First Meeting-April 4, 2011

 - Discussed current efforts
 - Decided to create an OASBO Concept Paper

 - Brainstormed Principles of Shared Services that OASBO should suggest
 - Created a 1st draft of concept paper
- ♦ Third Meeting- August 19, 2011
 - Panel of Treasurers/CFOs Serving two districts
 - Finalized draft of concept paper
- ♦ OASBO Leadership Conference-September 1-2, 2011
 - Reviewed and revised by OASBO Leaders who were attending
