



Ohio Attendance and Tuition Law


- RC 3313.64 Definition of Home
 - "Home" is defined as a home, institution, foster home, group home or other residential facility that receives and cares for children if:
 - the home is licensed, OR
 - the home is operated by a person who is licensed, OR
 - the home accepted the child through a placement by a person who is licensed, OR
 - it is a home that meets the statutory definition of a children's home.

Ohio Attendance and Tuition Law

- Special Admittance
 - Adult students
 - Married students
 - Adoption
 - Parent employed in school district
 - Parent in the armed services serving outside of Ohio
 - Death of a parent
 - Parent having house built
 - Parent has contract to purchase house
 - Custody proceedings initiated





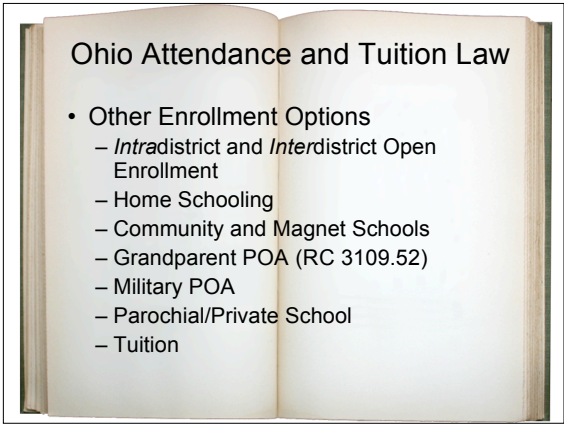

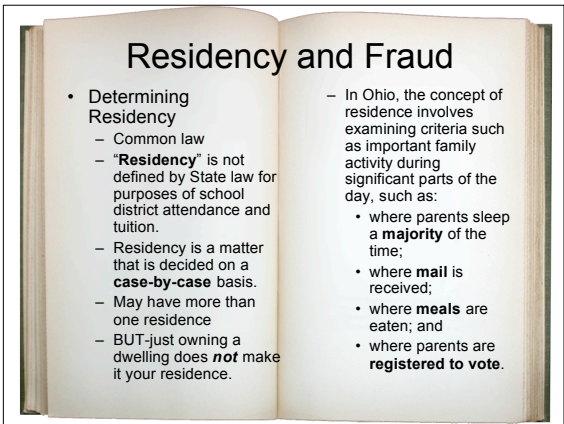


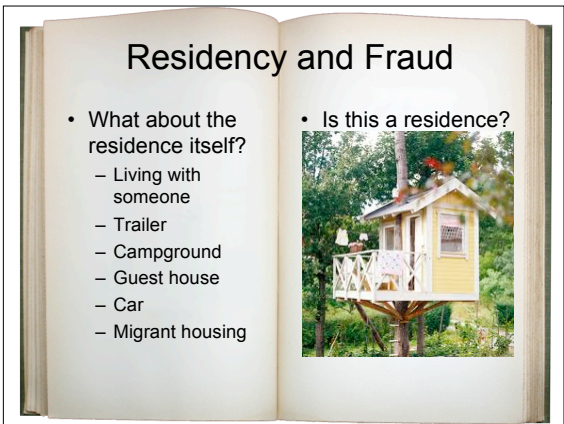
- Parent is district/ESC employee

- Child resides with grandparent

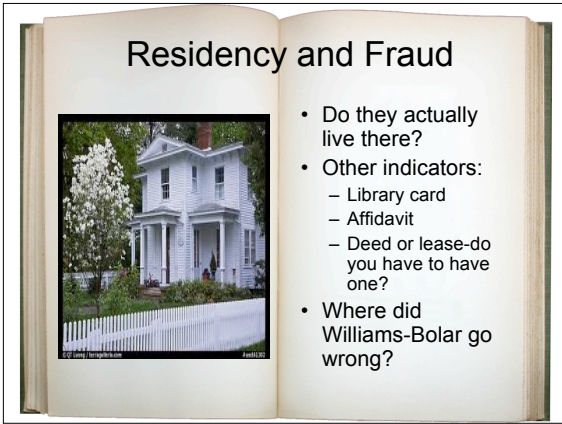
- Foreign exchange students

- Military POA

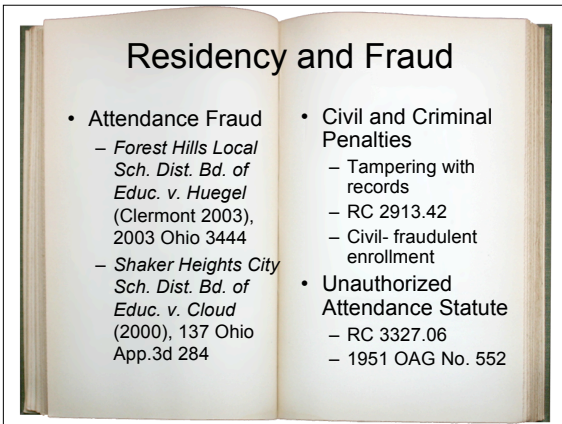


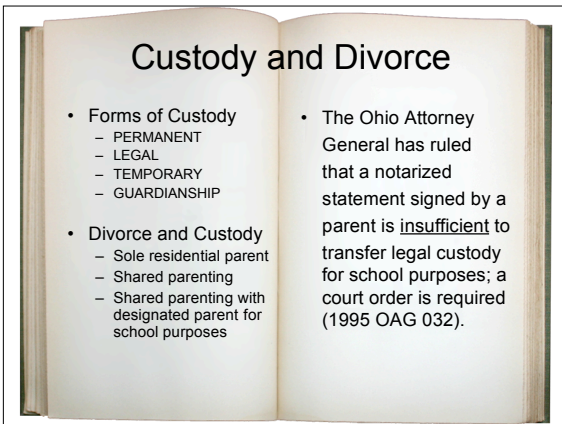


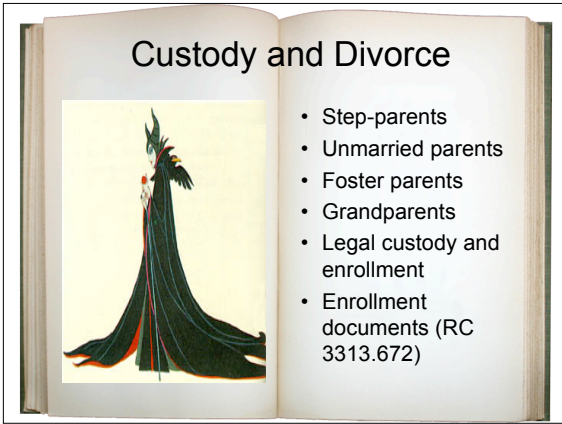


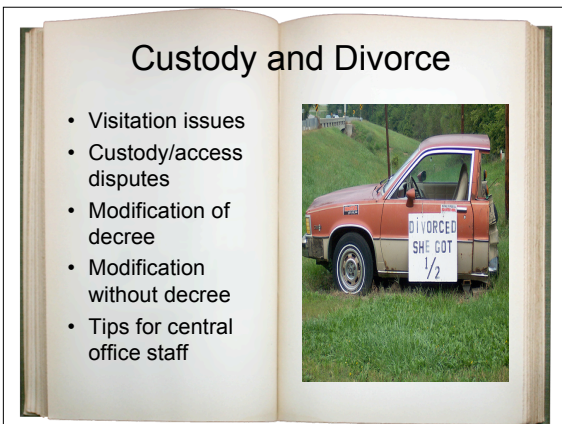


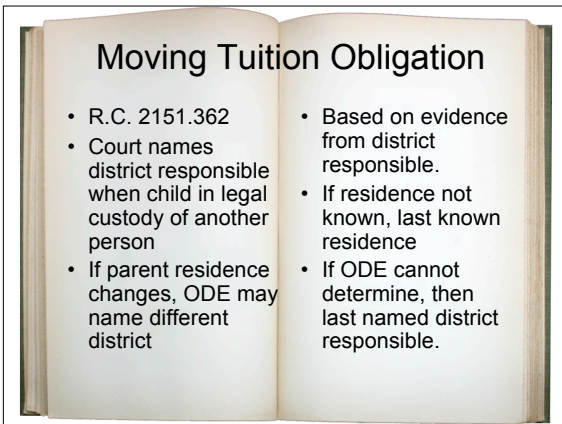




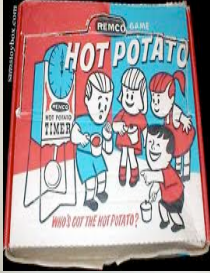








Moving Tuition Obligation
