 - o You're Expected to Succeed (YES) Classrooms--Teacher coach and teacher assistant
 - Deans of students
 - o Social-Emotional Learning curriculum
 - o Restorative Practices--all staff, all buildings, all classrooms
- PD in Restorative Practices, Trauma and Resiliency, Signs Of Suicide (SOS)

Canton City School District

Prior to 2018-19 and continuuing...

- Student Success
 - o Plan (Academic, Behavioral); Student Success coaches
- Comprehensive System of Learning Supports
 - o Care Team: Tiers 1, 2, and 3 (including Behavioral Health)
- Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS)
 - District--team, procedures
 - o Building--team, state-award winners (bronze, silver)
 - o Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI)--data, documentation

Berea City School District

Interventions for Students

- <u>Tier 1</u>--Classroom Management Tool (for all teachers to implement); building PBIS teams with support from pupil services
- <u>Tier 2</u>--Targeted research-based interventions (attendance intervention, mindfulness, study skills groups, etc.)
- <u>Tier 3</u>--Specially designed instruction (all students with special needs needing social-emotional/ behavioral intervention); sped coordinators
- <u>Tier 4</u>--Behavior Resource Rooms (with new position: Mental Health/ Behavior Assistant); Staff (Behavior Coach, Social Worker, Home Instruction Coach)

 - District and agency collaboration

Berea City School District

- District and agency collaboration
 - Intra-district
 - District-agency

Berea City School District

- District and agency collaboration
 - o <u>Intra-district</u>
 - Central office to buildings: district to building (PBIS tiers)
 - **Department to department:** pupil services and assistant superintendent's office (alternatives to discipline, threat assessment training)
 - Principals--discipline data, alternatives to discipline
 - Safety and Security Committee and Pupil Services
 - o Threat Assessment training and procedures
 - Youth Mental Health First Aid--community (police departments, community)

Berea City School District

- District and agency collaboration
 - BCSD and Ohio Guidestone
 - Threat assessment teams and training
 - Crisis teams and training
 - PBIS--Tiers 3 & 4
 - Project AWARE
 - Transition Bridge--Cleveland Clinic
 - o Day to Liv--First Ring Collaborative
