## Superintendent Search

The Trimble Local School District Board of Education is seeking qualified applicants for the position of superintendent of schools. The vacancy is the result of the anticipated retirement of the current Superintendent, Dr. Kimberly Jones. In addition to providing leadership for all the various programs and operations, the board is seeking an individual who is capable of articulating and achieving the district's educational mission.



## About the District

The Trimble Local School District encompasses approximately 39 square miles in the North part of Athens County. The district includes the Villages of Jacksonville, Glouster, and Trimble. With a total enrollment of 800 students, the district houses an elementary school, a middle school, and a high school.

The district was the beneficiary of an OSFC program which resulted in the renovation of the Elementary, Middle and High Schools.

The district also received an OSFC Corrective Actions Grant, which allowed us to purchase a new roof at the High School, new sidewalks at the Elementary/Middle School and other minor renovations.

Our schools are well supported by the com-

munity including a Textbook Foundation Committee, a group of alumni who annually conduct fundraisers to raise funds to purchase textbooks and supplies for our students. Over the past four years the Foundation has raised over \$400,000.

The district, which received a 2012-2013 state rating equivalent to Effective, based on the performance index, is committed to making the necessary improvements to achieve academic success for every child. We also provide a strong program of athletics, as exemplified by our football team, which this year made it to the Div. VII state championship finals.

Trimble Local enjoys a unique relationship with the Ohio University and Hocking College and encourages students to participate in college level classes through the Post Secondary Options Program.

We are the recipients of a 21st Century Grant in conjunction with Ohio University.

The District is also placing a permanent improvement levy on the May 2014 ballot, and is currently entering into an agreement to complete a HB 264 project, which will be used to upgrade lighting and construction of a vestibule at our elementary/middle.

## About the Community

A large part of the history of Athens, Hocking and Perry Counties in Ohio is the local coal industry. Glouster and Jacksonville are two of the cities included in the Little Cities of Black Diamonds Region. Coal mining once dominated every aspect of life and physical appearance of the community. Coal, one of Ohio's most important mineral resources was and still is, mined in the Glouster area.

Athens County, home to Ohio University and Hocking College, is nestled deep in the Appalachian foothills of Southeast Ohio.

Just over an hour from Columbus, three from

Cincinnati, and three from Pittsburgh, Athens Co. is a popular destination spot for outdoor enthusiasts, art lovers, history buffs and anyone who wants to escape the fast pace of the city.

Hunting, kayaking, hiking, cycling and mountain biking are just some of the most popular outdoor activities.

Burr Oak State Park, located South of Glouster has a rustic country charm in its scenery of wooded hills and valley farms. As one of Ohio's resort parks, Burr Oak offers a wide array of overnight accommodations with its lodge, cottages and campground. Burr Oak blends modern conveniences with the wilderness spirit of Ohio. Five launch ramps provide access to Burr Oak Lake for boating, swimming and fishing.

Glouster and Jacksonville are also the home of the Color in the Hills Festival, held in October, as well as the Old Settlers Festival, during Labor Day weekend.

## Qualifications
