Ohio Medicaid Schools Program (MSP): A Reimbursement Strategy for Schools



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Providers v Practitioners

- School districts can choose to be a provider in MSP
- Schools can contract with ESCs, clinics, individual practitioners for reimbursable services
- ESCs cannot be a direct 'provider of record'
- Nurses and therapists are 'practitioners'

Available Services

Medicaid Services available outside school setting

- Therapy Services (PT, OT, Speech)
- Nursing Services (IEP specified)
- Medical Equipment and Supplies
- Medical Transportation
- Administrative Activities • e.g., service coordination



Nursing Services

• Not all nursing services covered

- Only services for Medicaid eligible
- Only services on a student's IEP
- Because of RMTS, not all allowable nursing services are reimbursed
 - RMTS is a statewide pool
 - Because there are many school nurses, and most are low % of their time completing reimbursable services, they lower statewide RMTS
 - Check with your Special Education director if you have questions
