JANUARY THROUGH MAY

CALL FOR AMENDMENTS

School districts, career centers and ESCs are asked to review the OSBA Legislative Platform and propose changes by passing a resolution. Districts must submit a copy of the resolution, signed by the treasurer, to **Jennifer Hogue**, OSBA director of legislative services, by May 31.

JUNE THROUGH JULY

SUBMISSIONS ARE PREPARED FOR CONSIDERATION

OSBA staff collects resolutions and prepares materials for consideration by the OSBA Legislative Platform Committee. Materials are shared with committee members prior to the meeting.

AUGUST

OSBA LEGISLATIVE PLATFORM COMMITTEE MEETS

The committee reviews and submits recommended amendments to the OSBA Legislative Platform for consideration by the OSBA Delegate Assembly at its annual business meeting. The committee consists of four school board members from each of OSBA's five regions. Members of the OSBA executive committee serve as ex officio members of the committee.

NOVEMBER

THE ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING OF THE OSBA DELEGATE ASSEMBLY

Each OSBA member school districts may appoint one delegate to attend and vote at the annual business meeting, which is held during the OSBA Capital Conference. The assembly debates and votes on each proposed change to the OSBA Legislative Platform. At least 75% of the voting delegates must approve each item.
