Established in 1971 to consolidate resources across 546 square miles, the Switzerland of Ohio Local School District is the largest by land area in the state. To serve this vast, rugged terrain, the district operates five PK-8 schools, two high schools, and a career center. Our mission is simple: to support our communities by providing students with the chance to reach their highest potential, both inside and outside the classroom.

The district underwent a massive modernization in 2012, constructing seven new buildings and renovating an existing high school. This transformation was further accelerated by the 2014 shale boom, which provided a significant revenue windfall from oil and gas production. These funds transitioned the district from "belt-tightening" to a position of financial strength, allowing for major infrastructure projects and technological upgrades without the need for traditional tax levies.

Today, students benefit from diverse academic and vocational pathways, including a wide range of College Credit Plus (CCP) courses offered in-person, online, and at college campuses. The Swiss Hills Career Center has also evolved into a high-tech hub, featuring targeted lab and HVAC renovations completed over the last five years. Whether through traditional academics or modern industrial and medical training, we are committed to seeing our students thrive in a 21st-century environment.
