# Master of Transportation Administration Program

## MTA 2022 pricing

Individuals may register and attend single classes or register for the complete MTA professional development program.

The complete MTA program (6 classes per year), which includes certification of completion, is \$675. Individual classes are \$100.

This three-year curriculum includes classes in three proficiencies:

- **Governance (2022)** – state funding and T-reporting requirements; budget development and managing maintenance costs; financially sound routing practices; and policy development.
- **Compliance and safety (2023)** – driver records compliance; emergency planning; rules and laws updates; fleet compliance; and a peer-driven roundtable relating to the subject area.
- **Operations management (2024)** – personnel and student management; communication styles and public relations; routing and fleet management; and policy and handbook development.
